

LakeRacer LLC Monster Bash Poker Run Event Information.

In 2009 LakeRacer took us back to the early days of Arizona Hot Boats and the Fall Heatwave series poker runs by hosting the Monster Bash Poker Run. It was back to a little smaller and easier going event with a fun theme and costumes encouraged. As it was late in the season, only 50 boats signed up, but what a great time we had! Everyone who came swore they were coming back and many more who didn't make it declared they weren't missing the 2010 event. So welcome to the 2010 Monster Bash Poker Run on November 5 and 6th 2010. Like last year, we're supporting the Lake Havasu Food Bank, as our designated charity, so a percentage of the poker run jackpot will be donated and you are encouraged to make any other donations of non perishable food at the event.

This event is limited in number and size of boats. For boats thirty five feet and under, with special invitation to larger boats who have provided special support to our events. We want to encourage those who feel the Desert Storm event no longer accommodates their boat.

The Nautical Resort and Teague Custom Marine have encouraged us to organize this event with their sponsorships, so make sure and thank them!

This Poker Run is themed for Halloween to make it fun for the whole family. Included in this event is an opportunity for a holiday photo of each boat in front of the London Bridge. These will be included on an event photo CD to be mailed out after the event. We will host a reception and registration party Friday night in the Turtle Grill or Nautical Cove and an awards costume party Saturday night in the Nautical Conference Center. **By special request we will bring back the Friday Lunch Run to Havasu Springs, reserved only for those who register before October 15th, you will receive the special wrist bands by mail for it.** Depending on our permit request to BLM, we may even host a Friday morning shootout for some of our guys that couldn't do the Desert Storm version.

EVENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The registration fees: Each entry includes two poker hands, two t-shirts, two adult entries for the registration party, awards banquet, prize drawings, and holiday boat photo on an event photo CD.
- **Early Registration - on or before September 1, 2010 - \$175.00**
- **Late Registration - "ANY" Received after September 1, 2010 -\$200**
- **ALL REGISTRATIONS AT THE EVENT - \$250.00.**
- **No Registration Refunds given after October 15, 2010.**
- Additional Poker Hands are \$25.00, a limit of six hands per boat.
- Additional adult entries with T-shirt are \$40.00, including registration party; awards party, and prize drawings.
- Children wristbands are \$10.00 for Children 6 thru 12 and under. Children under 5 are free.
- Additional Poker Run T-shirts will be available for \$15.00 each.
- Any tied high hands will be decided by high card cut of a deck at dinner, there will be four high hand winners. Cash prize's determined by total hands sold with first twenty percent to a Charity to be decided.
- First Place - thirty-two percent,
- Second Place - twenty-four percent,
- Third place - sixteen percent,
- Fourth Place - eight percent.
- Nautical Inn has set aside a limited number of rooms for our event; a special rate (2-night min.) has been arranged. Reserve your room early! - **Card Turn in:** If you do not finish and turn in your hands to Poker Run headquarters by 5:30 PM, it will be assumed you have dropped out and have forfeited your entry. Exceptions granted: Equipment failure or assisting fellow boater. Poker run officials must be notified by 5:00pm of Participants name(s) and Boat.
- There is a 150 boat maximum number of entries. Maximum length of boats is 35 ft unless special invite by LakeRacer. If we reach 150 **paid** entries before the event, no additional entries at the event. Each participating boat must provide a copy of their current hull / liability policy and current boat registration.
- Each driver and all boat riders must sign a waiver and release. This release states, "In consideration of being permitted to participate in this event, the participant will not hold LakeRacer, L.L.C. liable should they be harmed during the event". In addition that they have not taken any illegal substances nor consumed alcohol 6 (six) hours before an event and will not consume either while driving the boat. Subject to disqualification!
- Personal Floatation Devices (PFD's / LifeJackets) are mandatory and are to be worn during this event while operating your boat. All occupants of the boat must wear PFD's.
- The Poker Run is NOT a race. There will be many boats on the lake not part of the run, please respect them.
- Each card station shall be considered a NO WAKE area, please approach from the stern at WAKELESS speed. Each station will be open the posted times only
- No refunds will be given; this would not be fair to the other participants. In case of unacceptable weather on Saturday, the poker run will be held on Sunday.
